The Blizzard Challenge 2011

Evaluating corpus-based speech synthesis on common databases

In order to better understand and compare research techniques in building corpus-based speech synthesizers on the same data, the annual Blizzard Challenges 2005–2010 were held. We are now pleased to call for participation in the seventh challenge: Blizzard Challenge 2011. The challenge is to take the released speech data, build one or two synthetic voices, and synthesize a prescribed set of test sentences. The sentences from each synthesizer are then evaluated through extensive listening tests. The tasks for 2011 are as follows:

• American English:

- Hub task EH1: a general-purpose voice from the full ~ 12000 utterance 'Nancy' data set (female professional speaker, US accent) kindly supplied by Lessac Technologies Inc., and available divided into utterances at 16kHz sampling rate, or as original studio session files at 44.1kHz and 96kHz sampling rates.
- Spoke task ES1: a voice from the full data set designed to read names and addresses (US format)

For both tasks, 16bit way files at any sampling rate can be submitted. The main listening tests will use way files downsampled to 16kHz. If there are sufficient entries at higher sampling rates, an additional listening test will be conducted.

Please note that the Blizzard Challenge 2011 runs concurrently with Phase One of the Blizzard Challenge 2012. We encourage participation in both challenges. For this reason, the range of tasks for 2011 is smaller than in some recent challenges.

Blizzard Workshop: The results will be presented at a workshop, which will be a satellite of Interspeech 2011, Florence, Italy (interspeech2011.org). The workshop will be scheduled for just before or just after Interspeech, at a location in Italy. A condition of participation in the Blizzard Challenge is the submission of a paper to this workshop. Accepted papers will be presented at the workshop, and published on the Blizzard website.
