## **CALL FOR PARTICIPATION**

## The Blizzard Challenge 2017

Evaluating corpus-based speech synthesis on common databases Simon King, Alan W Black and Keiichi Tokuda December 2016

In order to better understand and compare research techniques in building corpus-based speech synthesisers on the same data, the annual Blizzard Challenges 2005-2016 were held. We are now pleased to call for participation in the twelfth challenge: Blizzard Challenge 2017. The basic challenge is to take the released speech data, build synthetic voices, and synthesise a prescribed set of test sentences. The output from each synthesiser is then evaluated through extensive listening tests. The following is an outline description of the challenge – for full details and the rules of participation, please see the web pages.

- Main task 2017-EH1: UK English Children's Audiobooks About 6.5 hours of speech data from professionally-produced children's audiobooks will be released. This includes the data from last year's Blizzard Challenge. All data are from a single speaker. The task is to build a voice from this data that is suitable for reading audiobooks to children.
- Pilot task: to be decided.

**Blizzard Workshop:** The systems will be presented by the participants at the Blizzard Challenge 2017 workshop, which we anticipate will be held in Stockholm, after Interspeech 2017.
